Potty training tips at home for toddlers

- **Teach by example**

Go to the restroom with your child or have an older sibling go with them.

- **Call in the positive reinforcements**

Try getting a potty book and give your child the option of looking at the potty book while they sit on the potty.

- **Stay consistent**

Keep training and don't give in to stopping. Consistency is important.

Potty training Fees

At 30 months if your child is not toilet trained there will be an additional \$30.00 per month fee. Due on the 1st day of the month. Children are never punished or forced when toilet training. At 36 months if your child is not toilet trained there will be an additional \$30.00 per week toilet training fee. Due every Monday by 6pm.
